When you're ready, here is some useful information about how you can deliver the food you've collected to Wandsworth Foodbank.

WHERE CAN YOU DELIVER FOOD TO?

Please deliver collected food to our temporary foodbank warehouse just over Wandsworth Bridge:

 Unit C Hurlingham Retail Park, 364 Wandsworth Bridge Rd, London SW6 2TZ

Please stop and tell the security guard at the car park entrance that you are delivering to Wandsworth Foodbank. We are at the far door on the right, as you face the river. We would be grateful if you could wear face mask inside the warehouse please.

WHEN CAN YOU DELIVER IT?

You can deliver your food collection to our warehouse on:

- Mondays 10am-4pm
- Tuesdays 10am-4pm
- Fridays 10am-12pm

Due to the high levels of need we are seeing at the food bank currently, our team is at full capacity helping people and families referred to us. We're sorry that we're not able to arrange to collect food donations from schools and churches this year, and we're grateful for your understanding.
