

Our impact in 2025

We provide a warm welcome, emergency food, support and advice to local people and families in hardship, from our six food bank welcome centres across Wandsworth Borough.



We provided **13,054** emergency food supplies, with **6** in **10** going to local households with children. This is a huge **108%** increase in food supplies compared to 2019.



We supported **2,430** local individual households at least once - providing a warm welcome, emergency food, and advice to tackle root causes of hardship where needed.



The rising cost of essentials was the most common reason for food bank referral, followed by the impact of physical or mental health issues, then priority debt.



Our Foodbank Advice Project gave expert advice and support to **648** local people - resulting in a vital average income gain of **£1,435** per person, and reducing stress and worry.



We were powered by an amazing team of **306** wonderful local people who volunteered with us, giving more than **11,584** hours to support local people.



Generous people in our local area donated **113** tonnes of food and toiletries, and funds, so that local families and people didn't go without the essentials they needed in their hardest times.
